### SPARKLING

- Vivoli Prosecco** 25.00  
*Veneto, Italy*  
Lively and crisp with a little touch of fruit sweetness, this is a great example of Prosecco's appeal and adaptability.
- Chio Prosecco DOCG** 30.00  
*Veneto, Italy*  
A light refreshing sparkler from the premium Prosecco area of Asolo, slightly off-dry and full of pear fruit, the only danger is it's too easy to enjoy!
- Denbies 'Whitedowns' English Sparkling** 40.00  
*Surrey, England*  
This wine offers fresh citrus aromas with just a hint of brioche. The palate is crisp, dry and refreshing thanks to its finely balanced acidity. It has an enticing creamy texture and a persistent length of flavour.
- Langlois Cremant De Loire** 35.00  
*Loire, France*  
Sophisticated and classy fizz from the Loire Valley made using the Chenin Blanc grape and a touch of Chardonnay. This is a great value alternative to Champagne.

### CHAMPAGNE

- Ayala Brut Majeur** 45.00  
*Champagne, France*  
Light gold in colour, with a delicate mousse. The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus, florals and white fruits. Well balanced with a delicate complexity, Chardonnay adds a lively, fresh fruitiness on the palate, whilst Pinot Noir gives the wine richness and length.
- Perrier Jouet Grand Brut** 55.00  
*Champagne, France*  
Pale yellow in colour with a tinge of gold. A light touch of brioche on the nose along with floral notes of fresh lilies.
- Bollinger Nv** 70.00  
*Champagne, France*  
Bollinger is one of the oldest family houses still in existence in Champagne. Their methods have little changed and their wines are still outstanding.
- Krug** 195.00  
*Champagne, France*  
An intense, enchanting bouquet and full, round aromas. Flavours of roasted hazelnuts, ending with a flowery, beautiful fresh note.
- Armand De Brignac Brut Gold** 295.00  
*Champagne, France*  
Complex and full-bodied with fresh, light floral notes. Sumptuous on the palate with a delicious creamy texture, great depth and a long silky finish.

<i>Champagne, France</i> Bollinger Rose is the first non - vintage rose produced with careful blending of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Meunier with 5% still wine from Cote des Enfants.	
<b>Laurent Perrier Rosé</b>	85.00
<i>Champagne, France</i> Clear and wonderfully fresh, aromas of red and black fruit like raspberries, black cherries and blackcurrants.

<i>France Champagne</i> Produced in small quantities, only in exceptional vintages and then aged for 6 years. Light yet voluptuous and vibrant, showing a silky texture and a touch of raciness. Citrus, white flowers culminate in a long tight finish from the low dosage.	
<b>Bollinger La Grand Annee 2007</b>	110.00
<i>Champagne, France</i> One of very few Champagnes to be entirely barrel fermented, this results in a richer and fuller style of Champagne. Flavours of honey, candied lemon with citrus pink grapefruit and toasty biscuit.	
<b>Louis Roederer Cristal</b>	250.00
<i>Champagne, France</i> A savoury explosion of ripe fruit revealing red fruit, white chocolate, caramel and Danish pastry, typical of Cristal.

Ripe peaches, lemon peel and a light hint of vanilla oak.</p>	<p><b>Malvasia Del Salento Varvaglione</b> 28.00 <i>Puglia, Italy</i> On the nose, this wine is aromatic and fruity. Freshness and balance characterize its style, with persistent yet delicate flavours. It is a wine that combines the light taste of grape and a little tropical fruit with good acidity. Very easy drinking.</p>
<p><b>Michel Chapoutier Marius Blanc</b> 24.00 <i>Pays d'Oc, France</i> Citrus aromas with notes of grapefruit and ripe lemon. Ample, rich and fruity with well balanced acidity and ripe fruit flavours allow for a wine with great persistency.</p>	<p><b>Ferrer Vionta Albarino</b> 36.00 <i>Rias Baixas, Spain</i> Complex fruit aromas with green apple, kiwi and melon as stand outs, giving way to a melange of ripe fruits like peaches. Lees maceration has given it a body and structure with great personality. A long finish, highly aromatic wine with a saline touch; characteristic of the varietal.</p>
<p><b>Chapoutier 'Mirabel' Viognier</b> 40.00 <i>Rhône Valley, France</i> Notes of apricots, tangerine and honeysuckle. Exotic, complex, perfumed wine with a lively, clean, dry style.</p>	<p><b>Turkey Flat Barossa Valley White Blend</b> 39.00 <i>Barossa, Australia</i> A layered and thought-provoking blend inspired by the whites of the Rhone Valley. The underlying rich medley of fresh and roasted stone fruit is topped with a toasty note of spice-laced crumb. Balanced with a restrained zesty hit of ginger on the lingering finish.</p>
<p><b>La Joya Viognier Gran Reserva</b> 23.00 <i>Colchagua, Chile</i> Notes of peaches, white flowers, and tropical fruit on the nose. Fresh palate with citrus and ripe pineapple notes. Medium bodied with balanced acidity and a persistent finish.</p>

The finish exhibits salty notes and is very aromatic.</p>	<p><b>Rongopai Sauvignon Blanc</b> 30.00 <i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i> With this intense yet elegant wine you get a dance of blackcurrant leaf, passionfruit, gooseberry flavours along with complex smoky, herbaceous aromas. It has a textured mouthfeel and very long palate with exuberant, yet integrated tropical fruit. Citrus notes and flint add drive and further complexity to this powerful drop.</p>
<p><b>La Joya Sauvignon Blanc Gran Reserva</b> 23.00 <i>Colchagua, Chile</i> Full of smooth mineral notes, bright citrus aromas of grapefruit, lime and orange peel with flavours of juicy tropical fruits. Long and mouth watering finish.</p>	<p><b>Fontanafredda Gavi Di Gavi</b> 44.00 <i>Piemonte, Italy</i> One of Italy's most fashionable whites, it is noted for acute dryness and fresh, flinty acidity. This is a bright straw-yellow wine with greenish highlights. It has a full, delicate, elegant bouquet which brings flowers and fresh fruit to mind - mostly lemons, lilies of the valley and green apples. Its palate is attractively young, dry, fresh and well balanced.</p>
<p><b>Rongopai Pinot Gris</b> 29.00 <i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i> Spicy and floral with red apples and pear. Big and warm palate, well structured with baked quince and a touch of ginger.</p>	<p><b>Greywacke Kevin Judd Sauvignon Blanc</b> 54.00 <i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i> A delicious combination of ripe summer fruits and delicate floral perfume. Citrus blossom and elderflower entwined with nectarines and white peaches, mandarin and cantaloupe with a twist of lemon. Intensely flavoured, succulent and crisp with a delicate herbal infusion - quintessential Marlborough.</p>
<p><b>Acordeon Cafayate Torrontes</b> 31.00 <i>Mendoza, Argentina</i> Lively acidity and juicy fruitful aromas, ripe flavour chorus of nectarines, white peaches, tangy grapefruit, Asian pear and hints of minerality, orange zest and honey.</p>

Fresh and light, with a good minerality and discreet woody notes.

The wine has a round and expressive palate, full and grippy with a zesty acidity. It finishes with a long burst of mineral and lime flavours.	<b>Domaine Chanson Meursault</b> 101.00 <i>Burgundy, France</i> Fresh zesty aromas mixed with lemon on a hint of vanilla. Well crafted. Firm acidity and minerality. Pure and tight. Stylish personality. Long aftertaste.
<b>Domaine Chanson Mâcon La Roche Vineuse</b> 39.00 <i>Burgundy, France</i> Notes of lime blossom mixed with very fresh aromas of citrus fruit. Well-balanced with a lot of finesse. Well-structured. Long and refreshing aftertaste with citrus fruit notes.	<b>Klein Constantia Estate Chardonnay</b> 48.00 <i>Constantia, South Africa</i> Fresh and light toastiness on the nose with butterscotch and nutmeg aromas. Medium bodied with an elegant structure, the wine has a flintiness with a balanced acidity that leads to a long finish.
<b>Domaine Chanson Pouilly Fuissé</b> 57.00 <i>Burgundy, France</i> Very fresh aromas of zesty citrus fruit mixed with green apple and a delicate mint note. Subtle minerality. Taut and well-structured. Delicate with a long and refreshing finish.

**Avito Pinot Grigio Blush** 20.00

*Pavia, Italy*

Easy drinking dry rosé with light red berry fruits, soft citrus notes and long refreshing finish.

**Petit Broux Sancerre Rosé** 42.00

*Loire, France*

Delicate pink in the glass with a nose of wild strawberries and a refreshingly light, mineral palate.

**La Promenade Provence Rosé** 26.00

*Provence, France*

A beautiful expression of Provence rosé. Refreshing, elegant and delectable wine with notes of citrus and red berries. The finish is round and flavourful.

Sweet and fruity rosé

**Winston Hill White Zinfandel** 21.00

*California, USA*

Full of bold jammy red fruits. Off-dry style but with a light refreshing finish.

**Deakin Estate Rosé** 25.00

*Victoria, Australia*

An appealing mix of cherry, redcurrant and wild strawberries with hints of cinnamon spice. Soft, juicy and clean with fruit sweetness, perfectly balanced by crisp acidity.

Fuller bodied rosé

**Michel Chapoutier Marius Rosé** 32.00

*Pays d'Oc, France*

Marius rosé is an expressive and fruity wine, counterbalanced by a pleasant acidity coming from the two grape varieties of which it is made, Grenache and Syrah. An excellent accompaniment to salads, barbecues, grills and Mediterranean dishes.

**Château Des Ferrages Roumery Provence Rosé** 30.00

*Provence, France*

An elegant and very pale rosé, showing the characteristics expected from a top-end Provence rosé. Light floral and herbal notes with summer berries and citrus flavours give complexity.

**Langlois Saumur Rosé** 30.00

*Loire, France*

Fresh red fruit and sour candies, deliciously juicy on the palate, fruity and long-lasting. A delightful dry rosé to pair with charcuterie or fresh grilled prawns.

<b>Solar Viejo Rioja Crianza</b> 23.00 <i> Rioja, Spain</i> Rich aromas of oak ageing, such as vanilla, ground coffee and spices merge with intense notes of violet, and fruity flavours of raspberries and ripe strawberries.	<b>Gabbiano Bellezza Chianti Gran Selezione</b> 40.00 <i>Tuscany, Italy</i> The highest quality grapes selected in a single estate vineyard give us this powerful Chianti Classico wine, authentic and elegant.
<b>Ropiteau Freres Nuits St Georges</b> 86.00 <i>Burgundy, France</i> Delicate aromas of cherry and spice with cinnamon, clove, pepper, tobacco and liquorice. Lovely roundness, with good tannic structure. Well-balanced with nice length.	<b>Klein Constantia Estate Red</b> 48.00 <i>Constantia, South Africa</i> Intense red and black fruit with elegant notes of cinnamon spice on the nose. Full-bodied and savoury with a well-integrated oak component, ending with a long and rich finish.
<b>Domaine Chanson Gevrey Chambertin</b> 109.00 <i>Burgundy, France</i> Delicate floral fragrances of violet mixed with refreshing aromas of small red berries and spices. Well-structured and well-balanced. Beautiful texture. Complex spicy aromas. Well-crafted tannins. Persistent and refreshing aftertaste.	<b>Roda Rioja Reserva</b> 68.00 <i>Rioja, Spain</i> The nose is deep, fruity and delicately spiced whilst the palate provides flavours of cherries and silky, fine grained tannins. An overall feeling of freshness, this wine oozes delicate elegance.
<b>Baron Chartrons St Emilion</b> 32.00 <i>Bordeaux, France</i> Robust nose showing some forest floor with luscious sweet fruit and spices. A light toast and delicate palate with rich berry flavours of strawberry as well as plums, cinnamon and clove.	<b>Kilikanoon 'Prodigal' Grenache</b> 50.00 <i>Clare Valley, Australia</i> Dark chocolate, cherry, plums and lightly toasted French oak. The palate is a swirling melting pot of cocoa, cherry plum and spicy oak char which seamlessly combine with a fine natural acidity and silky tannins.
<b>Fertuna Lodai Maremma Toscana</b> 52.00 <i>Tuscany, Italy</i> The nose is vinous, intense and ripe with full fruit notes. The palate is warm, soft and well-structured. Nicely balanced with soft tannins and a long aftertaste.	<b>Fontanafredda Barolo Di Serralunga D'alba</b> 69.00 <i>Piemonte, Italy</i> Classic dark tar and perfumed roses on the nose, light in colour but with great power, concentration and well balanced ripe tannins. This is a wine to match with rich foods and game dishes.
<b>Beso De Rechenna Bobal Crianza</b> 29.00 <i>Utiel Requenna, Spain</i> This wine is made from grapes produced on old Bobal vines over 40 years old. A full bodied red with elegant flavours of cherry and plum.	<b>Fattoria Dei Barbi Brunello Di Montalcino</b> 73.00 <i>Tuscany, Italy</i> A powerfully structured style of wine, this Brunello is truly complex but the red berry, plum and cheery fruit shine through the savoury character. A muscular, full-bodied wine with great richness.
<b>Cabellero De La Cepa Malbec</b> 25.00 <i>Mendoza, Argentina</i> Complex aroma combination of violets, cherries and sour cherries in oak. Concentrated black fruits, ripe plums and tobacco leaves. Complex finish with remarkable sweet tannins and a long lasting aftertaste.	<b>Blason De L'evangeline Pomerol</b> 91.00 <i>Bordeaux, France</i> It is made from grapes grown in Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite)'s vineyards with the same care and attention as the Grand Vins but made from the younger vines. This allows for a fresher, and less-aged style of classic Bordeaux.

Gentle soft tannins and a creamy aftertaste.</p>
<p><b>La Joya Merlot Gran Reserva</b> 23.00  <i>Colchagua, Chile</i>                      Fruity nose with light, well-integrated oaky notes. Blackberries on the fruity palate with firm acidity, ripe tannins, and a floral note on the long finish.</p>	<p><b>Abbotts &amp; Delaunay Réserve Côtes Du Roussillon</b> 26.00  <i>Languedoc, France</i>                      Aromas of raspberries, liquorice, violets and blackberries with soft, smooth tannins and spicy notes. Long on the finish.</p>
<p><b>Lambisque Côtes Du Rhône</b> 26.00  <i>Rhône Valley, France</i>                      Made mainly from the Grenache, Cinsault, Carignan and Syrah grape varieties, this wine is deep, fruity and well-balanced with a fresh hint of liquorice. Light ageing in oak adds a touch of complexity.</p>	<p><b>Gabbiano Chianti Classico</b> 26.00  <i>Tuscany, Italy</i>                      The moderate use of the wood using large casks allows the wine to preserve the most natural characteristics of the Sangiovese grape, bringing fruitiness, freshness and tannin together so harmoniously.</p>
<p><b>Chateau La Croix St Emillion</b> 45.00  <i>Bordeaux, France</i>                      This is mostly made from the Merlot grape variety with a smaller quantity of a grape called Cabernet Franc added. It comes from the village St Emilion in Bordeaux. This wine has flavours and aromas of plums and blackcurrants with gentle spicy notes.</p>	<p><b>Roda 'Sela' Rioja</b> 42.00  <i>Rioja, Spain</i>                      The nose is bursting with red fruit aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries. The palate is elegant with lively, fresh flavours. The oak wood ageing is well-integrated and the finish is persistent.</p>
<p><b>Casa Ferreirinha Esteva Douro Tinto</b> 21.00  <i>Douro, Portugal</i>                      Balsamic aromas of cedar and red fruits like strawberry and cherry. Well integrated acidity gives exceptional freshness and vivacity.
